

## Blue – The Big Loop

Start from the car park near the Live and Let Live pub sign on the A44.



From the information board, head South West up to the top of the Jubilee Hill.



Keep walking straight across the top of the hill and pass the Jubilee monument on your left. Take the right-most track that leads West between the trees.



Cross over one road and continue until you reach Bringsty Forge.

Turn left and follow the road South. It will branch to your left twice, but continue straight and you'll be on a track going steeply downhill and left.



The track is now heading East and will connect to a road with a few houses. Before the first house turn right and continue East.



The track leads to a field. Turn right to go South-East across the field and it will connect to a road.



Pass "Barratts Bridge" and cross the bridge. Continue South until the road meets a T-Junction. You may see donkeys in the field ahead of you.




Turn left and head East along the road. The road passes a number of houses up ahead.




The road becomes a track heading East and starts to slope downhill. It becomes a narrow track between trees, sloping down to a stream and narrow bridge.




Note this path can be unpassable in poor conditions.






The track meets a road. Continue straight, on to the road, and continue East.

Cross the road and continue North-East up a steep hill.



Past a few houses the road turns left and heads West.

You find yourself in a clearing facing a house. Take the track that leads around to the left side of the house and continue West.



Pass a road and continue West. (the track ahead here is slightly off to the right)



The track follows behind a hedgerow and leads to a clearing in front of "Pool Cottage". Take the first left.



The track comes to a turning on the right which leads over a ditch. Take this turning and continue West.



You find yourself in a field. Cross the field and turn right on to the road, heading North.



Take the first left and follow the track uphill, heading West.



Pass through the apple glade with six connecting paths. Continue straight, heading West.



Pass the Gospel Oak and continue West back to the car park.

## Purple – The Flat Walk 30 – 45 minutes

Start by parking near the playing fields behind the Bringsty Vintage Living shop and Bringsty Café. Or why not park at the shop and go in?



From the playing fields, follow the road South (with the fields on your left).




When you reach a building ("The Orchards") turn left. The track veers right and heads East.




The track meets a road. Continue straight, on to the road, and continue East.



Past a few houses the road turns left and heads North.







You find yourself in a clearing facing a house. Take the track that leads around to the left side of the house and continue West.



Pass a road and continue West. (the track ahead here is slightly off to the right)



The track follows behind a hedgerow and leads to a clearing in front of "Pool Cottage". Take the first left.



The track comes to a turning on the right which leads over a ditch. Take this turning and continue West. Arrive back at the playing fields.



## Red – The Dog Walk

30 - 45minutes

Start from the car park near the Live and Let Live pub sign on the A44.



From the information board, head South West up to the top of the Jubilee Hill.



From the top of the hill look for the tree trunks with no branches and take the track heading South down a very steep hill.



At the bottom of the hill is open fields. Turn left and head North-East along the top of the field.



Along the hedgerow the field connects to a house ("Primrose Cottage"). Follow the road North-East past the house.



The road passes the pub ("Live and Let Live") and then on to more fields.





Turn right and walk across the fields heading for the hillside directly across the field.



Walk up the steep hill. This is "Red Hill" or "The Ridge".



The track runs to the bottom of the hill near the football pitch. Turn left and follow the road North.



Walk past both playing fields and then take the first left and follow the track uphill, heading West.



Pass through the apple glade with six connecting paths. Continue straight, heading West.



Pass the Gospel Oak and continue West back to the car park.
